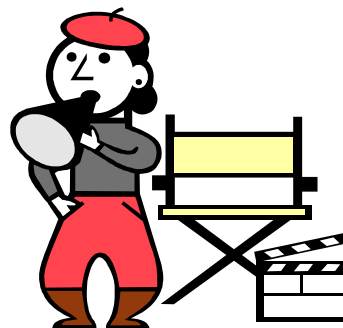
CELEBRATE THE SHOW SEASON AT THE 2004 AWARDS BANQUET

SECOND ANNUAL MID-ATLANTIC BREEDERS' SALE A SUCCESS—PLANS ARE UNDERWAY FOR 2005 EVENT!

The second annual Mid-Atlantic Breeders' Sale, held Wednesday, December 8 through Friday, December 10, at the Farm Show Complex in Harrisburg, began with a tack and equipment sale on Wednesday afternoon, followed by a preview showing of many of the sale horses. Saddlebreds and Hackneys were sold on Thursday morning and afternoon, followed by the first group of Morgan sale horses, with Morgan sales concluding on Friday morning.

A total of 80 horses were catalogued for the Saddlebred and Hackney portion of the event, in addition to 228 Morgans. Sale-goers had the opportunity to make a selection from a wide array of finished show horses, show prospects, broodmares and stallion prospects, as well as pleasure mounts.
